Join us on Tuesday, February 27 at 6 p.m. to learn about the upcoming Solar Installation Technician training program at Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College and connect with West Virginia-based solar companies. *Course begins March 5!*

Participants can attend in person on Eastern's Main Campus in Moorefield, or virtually via Zoom. Refreshments will be provided by the West Virginia Department of Agriculture.

The six-week hybrid course will begin March 5. The course will include educational modules and weekly live online webinar sessions between 1 - 2 p.m. on Tuesdays (March 5, 12, 19, 26 and April 2, 9) followed by in-person hands-on lab sessions on April 10-11. No prior experience or background in electrical systems and/or solar photovoltaics is needed.

By the end of the course, students should have all the skills necessary to design and install residential-scale solar electric system. Students will also be certified, after passing the examination, as a Photovoltaic Installer–Level 1 (PVI1) — a credential recognized around the globe.
